What is a LTR ?



On top of the PunchPlatform a few well-known variants have been designed. These are nothing else than mere punchplatform configurations. But it helps explaining the architecture.

- **LMC** : a complete server-side log management solution. Shipped with a rich set of standard log parsers.
- **LTR** : resilient and scalable data collectors to ship data accross sites..
- **LMR** : the receiver LTR counter part

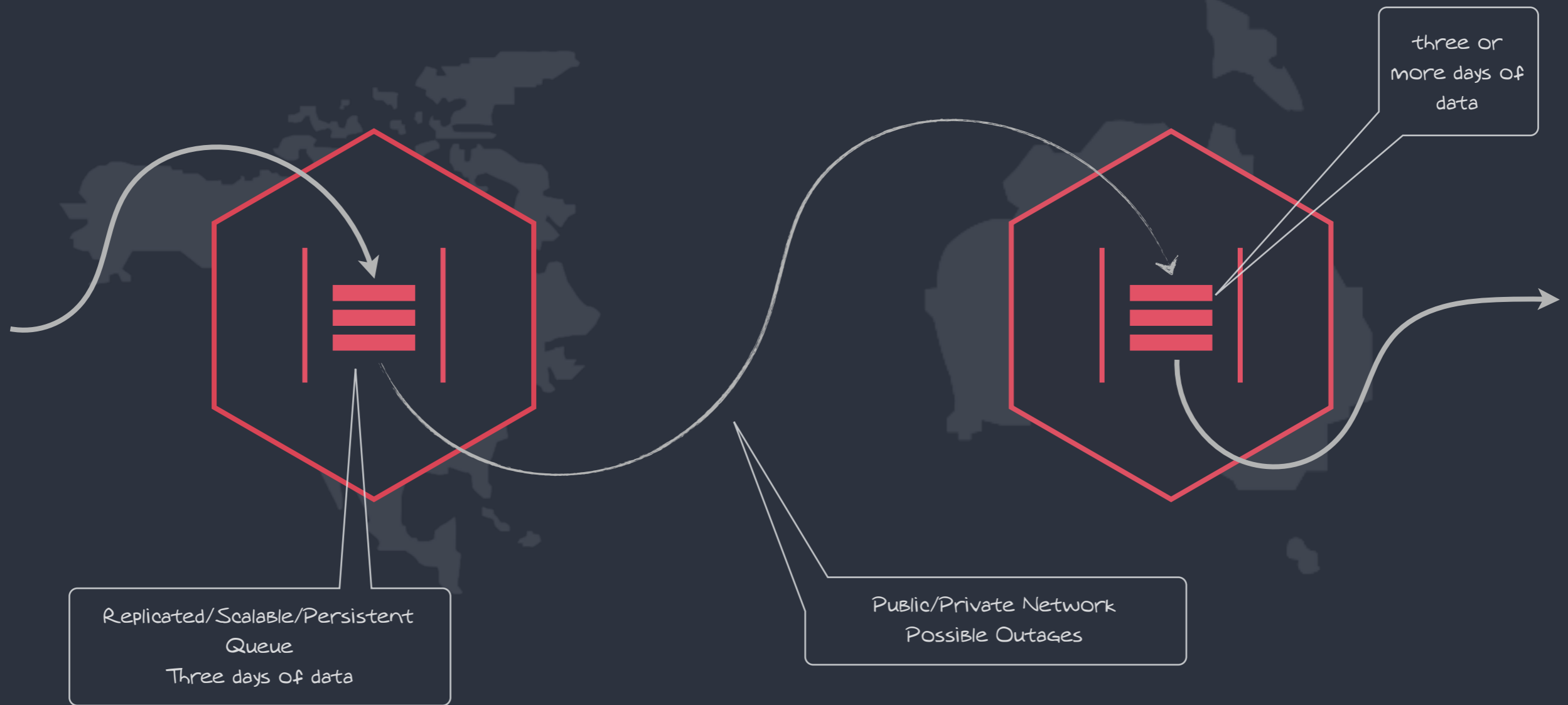

Goal : Site to Site data shipping

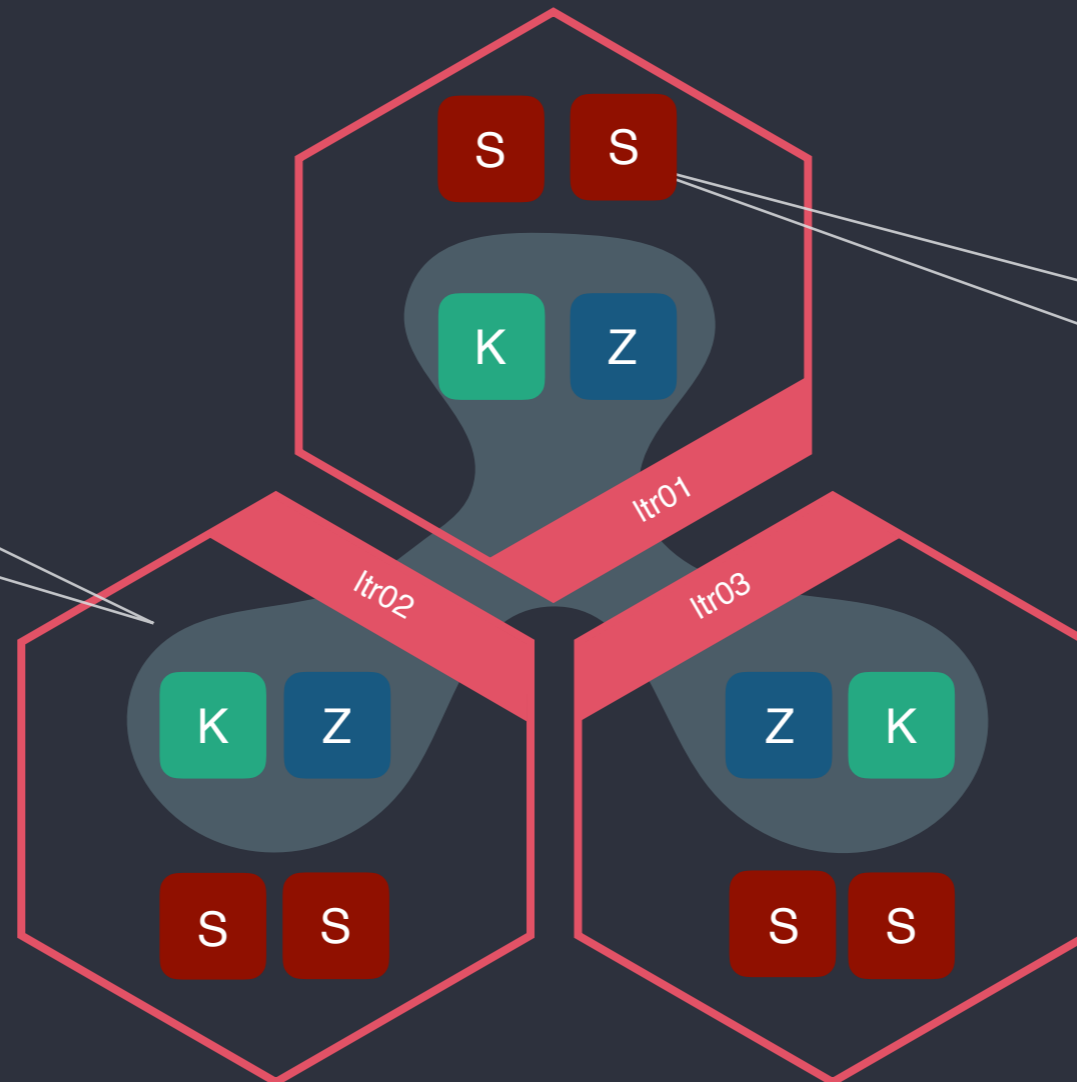

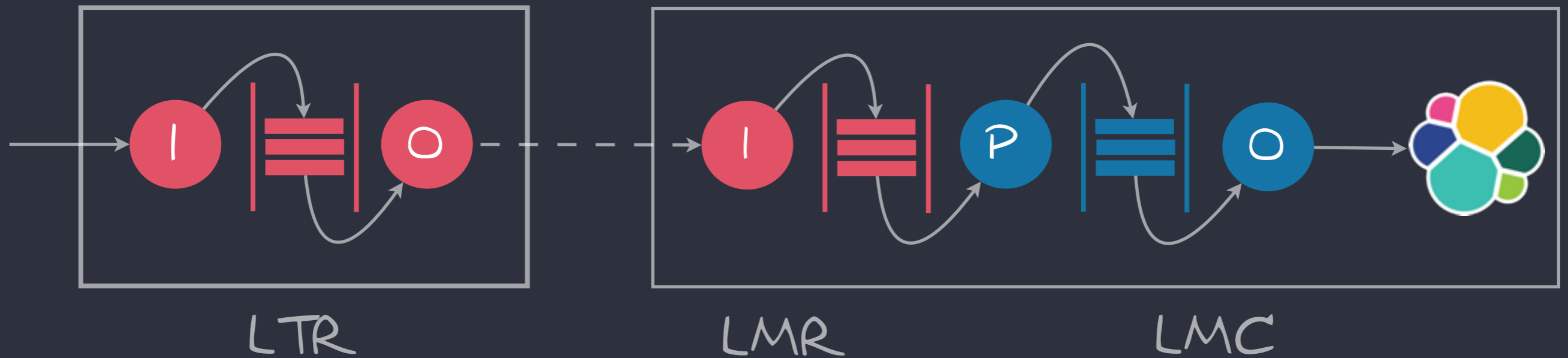
